



Admissions Process

Our Admissions Process at LSST has 5 steps which are detailed below.

Step 1: Online Application

An online application to the College will be completed online directly through our website (<https://online.lsst.ac/>)

Step 2: Documents Verification

1. A Valid ID(Please check the list provided for acceptable ID's) Non EU/British applicants require residence permit/Indefinite Leave to Remain
2. Updated CV– This is required for interview purposes
3. Personal Statement – stating why you wish to study the course you are applying for and what are your future goals
4. Previous qualifications (IF ANY)- Certificate and Transcript
5. Proof of address- most recent address, no later than 3 months, **DO NOT** accept driving license
6. **EU Applicants only**– EU applicants **MUST** bring 5 years of evidence, covering each month from September 2013 (bank statements, pay slips, utility bills, P60s for example) or 3 months of payslip along with a contract showing current employment.

Step 3: Online Maths and English Test (45 minutes)

Our Online Maths and English Test is for all applicants who do not meet the entry requirements and qualify as a mature student. The test is used for our admissions department to assess and support applicants whilst maintaining academic standards. The pass mark is 60%.

Step 4: SAPE Assessment – Screening for Accreditation of Prior Experience

Applicants who do not hold a Level 3 qualification or equivalent are required to sit a SAPE assessment. A SAPE is a set of essential questions related to an applicant's chosen course. Applicants may use the internet to answer the questions; however, detailed references must be provided. This assessment will take place under exam conditions. A SAPE assessment helps LSST understand and assess your computer skills and knowledge in your chosen course.

If applicants hold a Level 3 qualification in the relevant subject, they will be exempt from completing the SAPE, and will therefore move to step 5.

Step 5: Academic Tutor Interview

All applicants are all required to attend an academic interview with one of our lecturers. In the interview the lecturer will ask questions about the applicant's interests, future aspirations and what skills they can bring to LSST.
